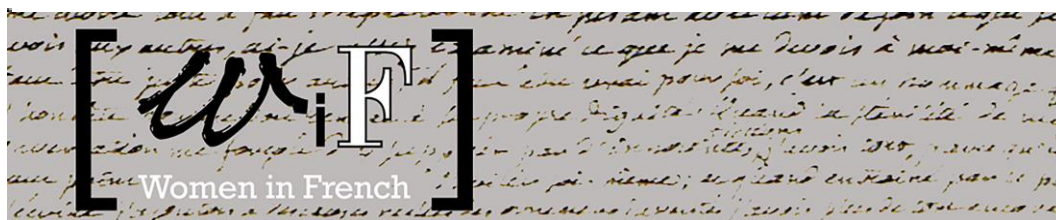

*Women in French Studies*, the refereed journal of Women in French (WIF), publishes articles in both English and French on any aspect of women in French-speaking literature or cultures (<https://womeninfrench.org/wif-studies>). The journal is a member of the Council of Editors of Learned Journals. Its articles are listed in the MLA Bibliography; articles from 1993 to present are also disseminated through the Project Muse database. Members of WIF receive two issues of the WIF Newsletter containing annotated bibliographies, conference announcements, calls for papers and articles, and useful addresses. WIF sponsors an annual prize for the best essay submitted by a doctoral student. Finally, WIF organizes international conferences on a regular basis. WIF members, men and women who work in these areas, may submit articles to *Women in French Studies* Executive Editor, Marijn S. Kaplan, at [marijn.kaplan@unt.edu](mailto:marijn.kaplan@unt.edu).
